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## About the arranger

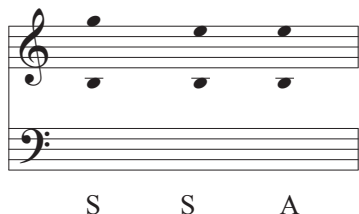
Dr. Stephen Caldwell is an award winning composer, educator, and conducting pedagogue, whose works have been heard in classrooms and concert halls throughout the world. His music has appeared on multiple All-State and All-Region choral festival concerts, and has been performed in Lincoln Center, and Carnegie Hall. His choirs have received international praise and recognition for their nuanced performances of works encompassing the entire choral canon.



## Note from the arranger

The Alleluia Canon, K. 553, by W.A. Mozart (1756-1791), is originally a single line, unaccompanied canon from 1788. To adapt and arrange the tune, there is a basic accompaniment in alberti bass style similar to Mozart's keyboard writing. The canon presents first as a unison, then in three parts. There is a short bridge of original music developing a melodic fragment of the fugue, before a full restatement of the canon in unison, ending with a small coda derived from the melody. The canon lends itself to the concurrent teaching of solfege, further helping develop choral skills.
