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About the composer

Hye-Young Cho (조혜영) (b. 1969) is considered one of the leading composers in South Korea. Her works have been performed in almost every choir and commissioned by most major professional choirs in South Korea. Notably, she was commissioned to write Te Deum for the opening concert of the World Symposium on Choral Music (WSCM) held in Seoul, Korea (2014).

Currently, she is the residence composer for Incheon City Chorale. She has also been the resident composer for the Ansan City Choir and National Chorus of Korea. She is the former president of the Korean Choral Composition Association (KCCA) and has taught at Hanyang University, Konkuk University, and Kangwon National University. She received bachelor's and master's degrees in composition at Hanyang University in Seoul, Korea.

About the poet

Sowol Kim (1902-1934), whose given name was Jung-Sik Kim, is one of Korea's most beloved poets. This poem comes from his collection of the first and only book published during his lifetime, *The Azaleas*, written as a teenager and published in 1925. The poem consists of three stanzas, and the composer repeats certain words and lines to maximize the musical and poetic effect.

The poem addresses a person who has lost a loved one and recalls the memory of this individual. As the years pass (s)he may forget things, but (s)he cannot, and will not, forget the loved one. The piano prelude depicts recalling memories of a lost loved one. Antiphonal singing throughout "Evocation" represents the recurring memories of the lost love. In the a cappella section, the depth of this sorrow is sung quietly with piano dynamics. The last section(coda) recapitulates the composition's opening, symbolizing bringing back the memory.


Commissioning ensemble

Evocation was commissioned by the National Chorus of Korea (Sang-Hoon Lee, former music director) and has been adapted for SSA chorus by the composer.
