About the Composer

Nancy Hill Cobb (aka Nancy Cobb-Lippens) (b. 1951) was named Founding Director of Music at Florida Gulf Coast University in Fort Myers, Florida in May 2005. Cobb was also selected in August, 2005, to be Artistic Director and Conductor of the Fort Myers Symphonic Mastersingers. She taught previously at Mercer University, Macon, Georgia, Oklahoma Baptist University in Shawnee, Oklahoma, and Dallas Baptist University in Dallas, Texas. She holds the BM with Honors (Theory and Composition) from Oklahoma Baptist University, the MM in Composition from Michigan State University, DMA in Composition from the University of Oklahoma. She also completed post-doctoral studies in choral conducting at the Eastman School of Music.

Cobb's works are included in the catalogues of a number of different publishing companies. She has been the recipient of numerous commissions from a wide variety of commissioning bodies. An ASCAP standard award winner since 1995, Cobb's *Threnody*, a 27-minute work for chorus and orchestra, was awarded a Special Distinction Award in the 1998 ASCAP Rudolph Nissim orchestral composition competition.
