About the composer

Neil Ginsberg (b. 1969) currently teaches music at the Harlem Day Charter School; formerly, he was the co-chair of the performing arts department at Brooklyn Friends School. He is a visiting teaching artist with the International Schools Theater Association and the Hotchkiss School Summer Music Program. Ginsberg has written theatre works with young people at the Berkshire Ensemble for Theater Arts, Encore! Summer Theatre Program, The Learning Theater, the American International School of Nice, and the Henry Street Settlement in New York. He has been the recipient of numerous awards including Meet the Composer, the Temple Guild of Young Composers, New York City Fringe Festival Audience Choice Award and New Dramatists. He is a former faculty member of the Juilliard School of Drama, 92nd Street Y, and the First Unitarian Church of Brooklyn. Additionally, he has written music for Off Broadway productions and is a sought after conductor and pianist.

Neil received his Bachelors Degree from the Hartt School, a Master of Arts from Brooklyn College, and a Graduate Certificate in composition from the University of Southern California where he received the BMI award for excellence in film composition.
